Commissioner Doherty moved to approve the minutes of the Regular Urban Renewal Agency meeting held on April 19, 2011 as presented. Commissioner Livingston seconded the motion. All were in favor (5-0-2)

Commission Doherty moved to approve the minutes of the Urban Renewal Agency Budget Committee meeting on April 26, 2011 as presented. All were in favor (5-0-2).

Chairman Phillips opened the URA 2011-12 Budget Hearing at 6:40 p.m.

Resolution #1-2011-Budget 2011-12

Commissioner Pratt moved to adopt Resolution 1-2011, a resolution adopting the 2011-12 Budget as approved by the Budget Committee on April 26, 2011 and make appropriations in the amount of \$338,500, and request that Morrow County Assessor divide the City of Boardman taxes under Section 1c, Article IX of the Oregon Constitution and ORS Chapter 457, for the maximum amount of revenue. Commissioner Doherty seconded the motion. Roll call vote was taken: Livingston-yes, Pratt-yes, Perry-yes, Doherty-yes, Phillips-yes. Motion carried 5-0-2.

Resolution #2-2011-Acceptance of State Revenue Sharing

Commissioner Doherty moved to adopt Resolution 2-2011, declaring the Urban Renewal Agency's election to received State Revenues. Commissioner Livingston seconded the motion. Roll call vote was taken: Livingston-yes, Pratt-yes, Perry-yes, Doherty-yes, Phillips-yes. Motion carried 5-0-2.
